BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on February 13, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a passenger shelter shed and platform at Gloster Station in the County of Kern, State of California.

Applicant alleges that it maintains a passenger shelter which is no longer necessary nor likely to be required in the future; that no passenger business has been transacted at said Gloster Station during the past year; and, that the continued maintenance of the passenger shelter shed at said station is unwarranted.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its passenger shelter shed and platform at Gloster Station, in the County of Kern, State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
