FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, it appears that winter snows and stormy weather make year-round operation of the service herein authorized impossible, and that through an inadvertence on the part of applicant such fact was not set forth in the application herein,

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the service between Truckee and Calpine, authorized by Decision No. 23152, may be operated seasonally, or approximately from May 1st to November 1st of each year, except between Truckee and Hobart Mills, between which points year-round service shall be given.

In all other respects Decision No. 23152 is to remain unchanged.
