SEVENTE ORDER PENDING FINAL DECISION

It being mutually agreed by the East Side Canal Company and the East Side Water Users Association to continue in effect for another year the modification of Rule No. 2 of the

Rules and Regulations of said company as set out in the Commission's Decision No. 22402, dated May 2, 1930, which eliminates the so-called dry period which extends from the sixteenth (16th) day of June to the thirtieth (30th) day of June each year, both inclusive, and that the irrigation period therein set forth be correspondingly reduced so that the irrigation period will terminate on the sixteenth (16th) day of August instead of the thirtyfirst (31st) thereof, and further Good cause therefor appearing, IT IS HEPEBY ORDERED that so much of the present Rule No. 2 of the Rules and Regulations of the East Side Canal Company as reads as follows: "First Period: The first period shall be from March 15 to June 15, both dates inclusive "Second Period: The second period shall be from July 1st to August 31st, both dates inclusive, be and it is hereby amended and modified to read as follows: The regular irrigation season shall be from March 15th to August 16th, both dates inclusive, and IT IS HEREBY YURTHER ORDERED that said Rule No. 2 as modified and amended herein shall become effective as of the date of this order and remain effective for the irrigation

modified and amended herein shall become effective as of the date of this order and remain effective for the irrigation season of the year 1931 only and that for the irrigation season of 1932 and thereafter the present existing Rule No. 2 of the Rules and Regulations of the East Side Canal Company be and it is hereby ordered to become effective again without further order of this Commission unless otherwise ordered.

For all other purposes the effective date of this

Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.

The foregoing Order is hereby approved and ordered filed as the Order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
