ORDER GRANTING CONSENT TO EXTEND TERM
OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

By its verified petition, Lone Pine Water Company, a corporation, prays that the Railroad Commission give its consent to the extension of its corporate existence for a term of fifty years from June 4, 1931. It appears that its Board of Directors has determined that it is for the best interests of the corporation that its term of existence be extended for such a period. The consent of this Commission to such extension is required under the provisions of the Civil Code, Section 401.

It appearing that such consent should be granted and that this is not a matter on which a public hearing is required, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA that consent be, and is hereby, given to Lone Pine Water Company to extend the term of its corporate existence to and including June 4, 1931.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Lone Pine Water Company shall file with the Commission, within thirty days after

the extension of its corporate existence, a certified copy of a certificate showing that the corporate existence of said Lone Pine Water Company has been extended.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the consent herein granted will become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
