SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, it appears from a sworn statement filed with this Commission by Lewis J. Sommer that the points served by said Sommer in the operation of an automobile passenger stage service under the name of Laurel Canyon Stage Line, are now entirely within the limits of the City of Los Angeles, and

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Act (Section 22 (b)), specifically provides that an automotive passenger stage corporation operating exclusively within the limits of a single incorporated city, town or city and county is not subject to the jurisdiction of the Railroad Commission,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore acquired by said Lewis J. Sommer, under authority of Decision No. 7972, issued on Application No. 5907, authorizing operation of said Laurel Canyon Stage Line, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission by said Lewis J. Sommer covering said service be and the same are hereby canceled.
