In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of two spur tracks across Independence Avenue in the City of South Gate, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, having on March 23rd, 1931, requested that it be permitted to construct the crossings granted by Decision No. 23514 of this Commission with grades of approach of four (4) per cent instead of two (2) per cent, as provided in Condition (3) of said order, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of said Decision No. 23514 is hereby amended to provide that said crossings be constructed with "grades of approach not exceeding four (4) per cent" instead of "grades of approach not exceeding two (2) per cent."

In all other respects Decision No. 23514 shall remain in full force and effect.
