SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, by Decision No.23185, the Railroad Commission authorized applicant herein to operate for a period of ninety (90) days an automotive passenger stage service through the Hormon district, and

WHEREAS, it now appears that applicant is desirous of operating said service for a further trial period of sixty (60) days,

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition No.1 of the order in Decision No.23185 be changed to read:

"That service herein authorized shall be operated for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days, at the end of which time applicant shall advise the Commission, in writing, if said service is to be continued as a permanent operation."

In all other respects the order in Decision No.23185 is to remain unchanged.
