O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on January 19, 1931,
applied for authority to abandon and remove its passenger shelter
sheds at the following non-agency stations on its Los Angeles Division:

Under date of March 12, 1931, applicant advised, in writing,
that it was agreeable to amending its application so as to exclude
the abandonment of the passenger shelter sheds at the stations of
Haines and Brownstone.

Applicant alleges that at the stations, other than Haines and
Brownstone, no passenger business was transacted during the year end-
ing October 31, 1930, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued
maintenance of the passenger shelter sheds is not necessary for the
business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its passenger shelter sheds located at the following non-agency stations on its Los Angeles Division, State of California:

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
