
BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER OF DISMISSAL.

Koshland Estate, owner and occupant of premises located at 110 Market Street, San Francisco, California, under date of February 25, 1931, filed a formal complaint against Pacific Gas & Electric Company (as successor to Great Western Power Company) in connection with the application of the latter's L-1, P-1 and C-3 rates for electric service.
