ORDER GRANTING CONSENT TO EXTEND  
TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, by its verified petition filed on March 7, 1931, asks the Railroad Commission to give its consent to the extension of its corporate existence for a period of fifty (50) years to and including April 10, 1981. It appears that its Board of Directors has determined that it is for the best interests of the corporation that its term of existence be extended for such a period. The consent of this Commission to such extension is required under the provisions of Section 401 of the Civil Code of the State of California. The Commission has considered applicant's request and believes that such request should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA that consent be, and it is hereby, given to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to extend the term of its corporate existence to and including April 10, 1981.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall within sixty days after the date hereof file with the Commission a certified copy of a certificate showing that the corporate existence of said Pacific Gas and Electric Company has been extended.
