In the Matter of Application of the Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger station building at the non-agency station of Lamoine, in Shasta County, State of California. ORIGINAL

BY THE COLLISSION

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on March 27, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove its passenger station building at the non-agency station of Lamoine on the Main Line of its Shasta Division in Shasta County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said passenger station building has not been used for the past several years; that the revenues derived at said station do not warrant the continued maintenance of said building; that the nearest station to the west is at Delta, a distance of 3.5 miles, and to the east at Castella, a distance of 15.1 miles, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of said passenger station building is not

WHILE

necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its passenger station building at its non-agency station of Lamoine, located on the Main Line of its Shasta Division, in Shasta County.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hero-of unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
