In the matter of the application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a passenger station building at the non-agency station located at 25th Street, between Valencia Street and San Jose Avenue, in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on April 15, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove its passenger station building at the non-agency station located at 25th Street between Valencia Street and San Jose Avenue on its San Bruno Branch, in the City and County of San Francisco.

Applicant states that it no longer operates passenger trains on this branch and that said passenger station building is not now necessary nor likely to be required in the future.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its passenger station at 25th Street between Valencia Street and San Jose Avenue on the San Bruno Branch in the City and County of San Francisco,

State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of this facility.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
