ORDER

WHEREAS San Fernando Telephone and Telegraph Company, operating a telephone system in San Fernando and vicinity, having filed with the Railroad Commission an application for authority to make effective a hand set telephone rate which shall be the charge for desk set telephone service plus twenty-five (25) cents per month; and

WHEREAS the Railroad Commission has heretofore, in formal proceedings, recognized the correctness of this rate differential and has ordered in effect said rates with such differential; and

WHEREAS the rendering of telephone service with hand set telephones is in the interest of subscribers of the San Fernando Telephone and Telegraph Company and it appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not required,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Fernando Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is authorized to charge and collect

for telephone service with hand set, the charge for desk set telephone service plus twenty-five (25) cents per month, effective on and after June 1, 1931, provided said rate be submitted to the Railroad Commission for filing on or before May 25, 1931.
