FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, by its order herein in Decision No. 23599,
inbound and outbound routes, differing in detail, were fixed,
and

WHEREAS, applicant, Original Stage Line, Inc. desires
to operate only on one route, to-wit: the "In-Bound" route,
and not the "Out-Bound" route; and

Good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the routes "In-Bound" and
"Out-Bound" as set up in said decision be, and the same hereby
are stricken out, and the following route established for op-
eration in both directions:

From 10th and Olive Avenue in Burbank, Olive Avenue to San Fernando Road, San Fernando Road to depot located at 141 East San Fernando Road, thence easterly to Angeleno Street, Angeleno Street to First Street, First Street west to Olive Avenue, Olive Avenue to Hollywood Way (Dark Canyon Road), Hollywood Way (Dark Canyon Road) to Cahuenga Boulevard, thence southerly on Cahuenga Boulevard to terminal located at 1625-1629 Cahuenga Boulevard, Hollywood.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said order in Decision No. 23599 shall remain as heretofore entered.
