An agreement has been entered into under the terms of which the Dolbeer & Carson Lumber Company will sell the stock of the Humboldt Northern Railway Company to the Little River Redwood Company. The transfer of this stock carries with it the transfer of all the properties of the railway company, except the equipment to which reference has been made. This equipment will be used by the Dolbeer & Carson Lumber Company in its lumbering operations in the forests adjacent to the Bucksport & Elk River Railroad.

It appears of record that the Little River Redwood Company will use the line of railway of the Humboldt Northern Rail-way Company to handle its own lumber and for such other purposes as may be necessary.

No protest to the granting of this application has been filed with the Commission.

## ORDER

The Commission has considered the evidence submitted at the hearing had before Examiner Fankhauser on May 11th and is of the opinion that this application should be granted, therefore,

TT IS HERRESY ORDERED that the Humboldt Northern Railway Company may, on or before October 1, 1931, sell to the Dolbeer & Carson Lumber Company, the rolling stock and equipment referred to in the foregoing opinion; said authority being granted upon the condition that said Humboldt Northern Railway Company continue to operate its line of railway as a common carrier until such time as it is permitted to cease such operation.
