Hearings in the above-entitled application of Victor A. Dunn for certificate to establish an electric plant in Lake County were conducted by Examiner Williams at Middletown and San Francisco. At the final hearing, February 20, 1931, the application was removed from the calendar, as applicant wished time to consider further prosecution of said application, and stipulated that if he did not advise this Commission within sixty days thereafter that he intended to prosecute same, it might be dismissed.
