FOURTE SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In its Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182, dated December 15, 1930, this Commission granted to Harold G. Laub a preliminary certificate covering the construction by applicant of gas plants and systems in Barstow and Victorville for the distribution and sale of liquefied natural gas and the exercise by applicant of the rights and privileges granted under Ordinances Nos. 335 and 336 of the County of San Bernardino, all subject to certain conditions, among which was the following:

- "(7) Upon the filing of contract-agreements and stipulations referred to in Conditions (1), (2) and (3) above in satisfactory form, the Commission will issue its Supplemental Decision authorizing the exercise by applicant of the rights and privileges granted to him under his franchise."

Applicant, now having satisfactorily complied with all of the conditions set forth in Decisions Nos. 23181 and 23182,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY ORDERS AND DECLARES that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and the same is hereby granted to Harold G. Laub

covering the construction, maintenance and operation of the gas plants and systems in Victorville and Barstow and the exercise of the rights and privileges granted to him under Ordinances Nos. 335 and 336 of the County of San Bernardino, insofar as such exercise is necessary for this specific project and provided that the Railroad Commission may hereafter, by appropriate proceedings and orders, revoke or limit, as to territory not then served by Harold C. Laub, his successors or assigns, the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be from and after the date hereof.
