Ilo with the Commission the consent of the landowners for whose benefit said crossing is melnteined to the closing of said crossing. Upon the completion of the crossing herein authorized and upon its being opened to public use and travel, said private crossing shall be effectively closed to public use.

In ail other respects the Compassion's Decision NO. 23175, in the above entitled application, shall remain in foll force and effect.
