ORDER

ORIGINAL

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, on May 1, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a freight platform located at New Delhi Station on its Santa Ana-Huntington Beach Line, in the City of Santa Ana, County of Orange, and shown in yellow on a blue print map (C.E.R. 13114) attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that no freight business has been transacted at New Delhi Station for the past several years; that there are no prospects that said freight platform will be required in the future, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the freight platform is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a freight platform located at New Dehli Station on its Santa Ana-Huntington Beach Line, in the City of Santa Ana, County of Orange, State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
