BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the temporary removal of the switch located in a spur track at Wunpost Station, in the County of Monterey, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on May 22, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove the switch from a spur track at Wunpost Station in Monterey County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said track is owned by it and that the track was originally constructed as a side track more than twenty (20) years ago and subsequently changed to a spur track for use in the handling of carload business, and that said spur track is not now being used.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove the switch from a spur track serving Wunpost Station in Monterey County and as

more definitely shown in yellow on the map (Coast Division Drawing 24653) attached to the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
