FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company having on May 26, 1931, requested, in writing, that a modification be made in the hours that the agencies be maintained at Honcut and Palermo Stations, Butte County, as specified in Decision No. 23682, dated May 11, 1931, it appears that a public hearing is not necessary and that said request should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the hours for maintaining an agent at the stations of Honcut and Palermo, County of Butte, as specified in Decision No. 23682, dated May 11, 1931, be modified as follows:

"An agent shall be maintained at each of said stations for approximately four (4) hours each day."

In all other respects Decision No. 23682 shall remain in full force and effect.
