## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, applicant has advised the Commission that it desires to continue operation of its bus service through the Hermon district, authorized by Decision No.23185, for an additional ninety (90) days,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit fixed for such operation by Decision No.23559 be and the same is extended ninety (90) days from June 6, 1931, with the provision that during said period the service may be modified in accordance with wired request for extension of trial period.

In all other respects the order of the Commission in Decision No.23185 is to remain unchanged.
