ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on March 12, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a combination freight and passenger station building located at the non-agency station of Sespe, on the Santa Paula Branch of its Los Angeles Division, in Ventura County, State of California.

IT IS HERREY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its combination freight and passenger station building located at the non-agency

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
