O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on March 12, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a combination freight and passenger station building located at the non-agency station of Sespe, on the Santa Paula Branch of its Los Angeles Division, in Ventura County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that said station building has not been used for the past several years; that said station building is not now needed, nor likely to be required in the future, and that the continued maintenance of said station building is unwarranted.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its combination freight and passenger station building located at the non-agency

station of Sespe on its Santa Paula Branch in Ventura County,
State of California.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter,
notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the
facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the
conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become
void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof,
unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective
on the date hereof.
