OPINION and ORDER

This is am application by Los Angeles Railway Corporation, a corporation and the Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, operating under the name of the Los Angeles Motor Coach Company, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate passenger automobile stage service, as a common carrier, between the intersection of Vermont Avenue and Monroe Street and the Greek Theatre, located in Vermont Canyon, Griffith Park, in the City of Los Angeles.

It is proposed to charge fares in accordance with Exhibit "B", which is attached to the application herein and made a part thereof. Service is to be given only when performances are given in the Greek Theatre, at which times such service as is necessary will be operated. The proposed service has been approved by the Board of Public Utilities and Transportation of the City of Los Angeles. Applicants claim they have been frequently importuned to provide transportation on such occasions.

. We are of the opinion that this application should be granted. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY
DECLARES that public convenience and necessity requires the operation
by Pacific Electric Railway Company and Los Angeles Railway Corporation
operating under the name of Los Angeles Motor Coach Company of an
automobile service for the transportation of passengers over and along

the following route: From the intersection of Vermont Avenue and Monroe Street, northerly on Vermont Avenue and Vermont Canyon to entrance of the Greek Theater; returning via reverse route. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity for such a service be and the same is hereby granted to Pacific Electric Railway Company and Los Angeles Railway Corporation operating under the name of Los Angeles Motor Coach Company subject to the following conditions: 1- That the service may be operated at such times as performances are given in the Greek Theatre, and may be discontinued when the theatre is not in use. 2- Applicants shall file their written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed fifteen (15) days from date hereof. 3- Applicants shall file, in duplicate, and make effective within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof a tariff or tariffs constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's General Orders and containing rates and rules which, in volume and effect, shall be identical with the rates and rules shown in the exhibit attached to the application insofar as they conform to the certificate herein granted. 4- Applicants shall file, in duplicate, and make effective within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date hereof time schedules, covering the service herein authorized, in a form satisfactory to the Railroad Commission. 5- The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured. 6- No vehicle may be operated by applicants herein unless such vehicle is owned by said applicants or is leased by them under a contract or agreement on abbasis satisfactory to the Railmad Commission. -2For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
