ORDER

The Pacific Electric Railway Company filed the above entitled application on June 29th, 1931, requesting authority to abandon and remove its shelter station and to relocate its passenger landing at Wilshire Boulevard and Santa Monica Boulevard, in the City of Beverly Hills, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Applicant alleges that the shelter station is located on property not owned by applicant; that the owner of said property has requested applicant to remove same and that public convenience and necessity no longer require the maintenance of said shelter station.

Applicant and the City of Beverly Hills, under date of June 1st, 1929, entered into an agreement whereby applicant is given permission to so attach its wigwag circuits to the highway traffic signals located at said intersection that the same will be synchronized with the railway operations. The relocation of the

outbound passenger landing is sought so that the trains of the railway will be able to proceed across Wilshire Boulevard before stopping, thereby preventing undue delays to vehicular traffic on Wilshire Boulevard.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove its passenger shelter station, as shown in yellow, and to relocate its landing platform from the position shown in yellow to the position shown in red, on the blue print map (Dwg. No. C.E.H. 13226), attached to the application, at the intersection of Wilshire and Santa Monica Boulevards, on its Santa Monica via Beverly Hills Line, in the City of Beverly Hills, County of Los Angeles, State of California, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment and relocation of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
