FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Fred Winkler, to whom this Commission, by Decision No. 12522, dated August 22, 1923, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile service for the transportation of passengers "between Valley Springs and Sheep Ranch, serving San Andreas and intermediate points," has advised the Commission, in writing, that he is no longer performing said service, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said Fred Winkler by Decision No. 12522 be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules covering said service filed with the Railroad Commission by said Fred Winkler are hereby canceled.
