FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Henry S. Musgrave, to whom this Commission by its Decision No. 15714, dated December 5, 1925, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers, freight and express between Yreka and Walker and intermediate points, has advised the Commission, in writing, that he has not performed said service since July 1, 1930, now.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Henry S. Musgrave by Decision No. 15714 be and the same is revoked and annulled, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that tariffs and time schedules covering the service authorized by Decision No. 15714 be and the same are hereby canceled.
