FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company having on August 11th, 1931, filed its Supplemental Application, asking for a modification of Condition (4) of this Commission's Decision No. 23891, dated July 13th, 1931, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (4) of said Decision No. 23891 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (4) No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing without first having been brought to a stop and unless traffic on the highway be protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as flagman.

In all other respects Decision No. 23891 shall remain in full force and effect.
