SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicants having on August 26th filed with this Commission a request for an extension of time in which to install the wigwag specified in the Commission's order of its Decision No. 23744, dated June 1, 1931, in this proceeding, and it appearing under the conditions that this request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Southern Pacific Company shall install a Standard No. 3 wigwag, as specified in General Order No. 75 of this Commission, for the protection of the grade crossing of Sepulveda Boulevard and the tracks of its Coast Line (Crossing No. E-453.9), in the City of Los Angeles, to be completed on or before October 31, 1931, subject to the conditions set forth in said Decision No. 23744.
