FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 23598, dated April 13, 1931, ordered that Santa Barbara Telephone Company might make effective in its Santa Ynez Exchange Area the rates set forth in the Opinion preceding its order, after a showing that it is ready to make available in its Santa Ynez Exchange Area continuous automatic service as proposed and upon Supplemental Order by the Railroad Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission has evidence that Santa Barbara Telephone Company has complied with the Order in Decision No. 23598, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Santa Barbara Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective as of October 1, 1931, the rates found reasonable in Decision No. 23598, provided said rates be submitted for filing with this Commission on or before September 15, 1931.

For all other purposes the effective date of this Order

shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
