O R D E R

The San Diego and Arizona Railway Company, a corporation, on July 20, 1931, applied for authority to abandon its agency at Lemon Grove Station on its Lakeside Branch, in San Diego County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at said agency station during the year ending June 30, 1931; that \$121.24 less than carload and \$14,716.95 carload freight business was transacted during the same period; that the nearest agency to the west is at San Diego, a distance of 8.8 miles, and to the east at La Mesa, a distance of 2.5 miles; that the principal interested shippers and receivers of freight have been interviewed by applicant, and have expressed their approval of the proposed agency abandonment; that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; that the station will be continued as a non-agency station; and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on August 12, 1931, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that this application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the San Diego and Arizona Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon its agency at its station of Lemon Grove, located on its Lakeside Branch in San Diego County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly; provided that said station be continued as a non-agency station.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
