O R D E R

East Bay Street Railways, Ltd., having requested author-  
ity to abandon its line along Dana Street and Allston Way in the  
City of Berkeley, County of Alameda, and in lieu thereof to oper-  
ate a street railway line along Bancroft Way and Fulton Street and  
it appearing that said request is reasonable and that this is not  
a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the East Bay Street Railways,  
Ltd. be authorized to abandon that portion of its line along Dana  
Street between Bancroft Way and Allston Way and along Allston Way  
between Dana Street and Oxford Street in the City of Berkeley,  
County of Alameda; to remove its tracks, poles, switches and ap-  
pliances therefrom and to operate its street railway line along  
Bancroft Way, Fulton Street and the proposed extension of Oxford  
Street between Bancroft Way and Allston Way and to construct all  
necessary tracks, switches, poles, connections and appliances on  
Fulton Street and the proposed extension of Oxford Street.

Applicant shall give at least ten (10) days notice of

the proposed change of route by posting suitable notice in its cars operating on said line.

The effective date of this order shall be of the date hereof.
