ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, on September 14, 1931, applied for authority to abandon and remove a freight platform located at Rosecrans Avenue on its Watts-Redondo Line in Los Angeles County.

Applicant alleges that during the past five years, it has handled only one shipment at said freight platform, which shipment was in the year 1926 and produced a revenue in the sum of seventy-four cents, and that in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the freight platform is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to abandon and remove a freight platform located at Rosecrans Avenue on its Watts-Redondo Line, in Los Angeles County, State of California, and shown in yellow on blue print map (C.E.H. 13344) attached to the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein, and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void, if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
