G.A. Reichman, owning and operating a public utility water system supplying water to the residents of Fort Jones, Siskiyou County, having requested permission from this Commission to transfer and convey said system to The California Oregon Power Company, a corporation, which joins in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that G.A. Reichman be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to The California Oregon Power Company, a corporation, his public utility water system as more particularly described in Exhibits "D" and "E" attached to the application herein, and that The California Oregon Power Company be and it is hereby authorized to purchase, acquire and operate said water system, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been

made on or before the thirty-first day of October, 1931, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said G.A. Reichman within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which G.A. Reichman actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession were relinquished.
3. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate-fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that upon due and proper compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order, G.A. Reichman shall thereupon and thereby stand relieved of all public utility obligations and liabilities in connection with the properties herein authorized to be sold and transferred.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
