FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 23781, dated June 15, 1931, ordered that Dos Palos Telephone Company might file and make effective the rates for exchange telephone service set forth in Exhibit "A" attached thereto and area maps as shown in applicant's Exhibit No. 3, presented at the hearing, after a satisfactory showing that it has changed all of its grounded lines to metallic circuits, and upon Supplemental Order from the Railroad Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission has evidence that Dos Palos Telephone Company has complied with the Order in Decision No. 23781, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Dos Palos Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to publish, file and make effective as of November 1st, 1931, the rates and maps authorized in Decision No. 23781, provided said rates and maps be submitted for

filing with this Commission on or before October 20th, 1931.
