OPINION AND ORDER

In this proceeding the Railroad Commission is asked to make an order authorizing the transfer of a warehouse business conducted by Christine Rodberg and Levi Brostrom, a copartnership under the fictitious name of Hilmar Warehouse Company, at Hilmar, California, to Levi Brostrom, an individual.

Christine Rodberg now owns a two thirds interest in the warehouse and a one third interest is owned by Levi Brostrom. It is desired to dissolve the partnership, Christine Rodberg disposing of her interest and title in the warehouse business and miscellaneous assets, including certain machinery and equipment contained in warehouse building known as Number 1, located at Hilmar, California, for the consideration of twenty-four hundred and forty-six dollars (\$2,446.00) to be paid by Levi Brostrom, in the amount of two thousand ninety-six dollars (\$2,096.00) in cash and a promissory note due in one year in the sum of three hundred fifty dollars (\$350.00).

The warehouse company was formerly owned by Jacob Rodberg and Levi Brostrom. The former is now deceased, and Christine Rodberg, his widow, is unable to properly look

after her interest in the business. The warehouse properties are now operated as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations contained in California Warehouse Tariff Bureau Warehouse Tariff No. 6-A, C.R.C. No. 48, on file with the Commission. Levi Brostrom will continue to operate the warehouse as a public utility under the same rates, rules and regulations. The proposed transfer will not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter not requiring a formal hearing and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. Christine Rodberg and Levi Brostrom, a copartnership, on the one hand shall immediately file a common supplement to the tariff, withdrawing, and Levi Brostrom on the other hand accepting and establishing such tariff and all effective supplements thereto.
2. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be sold, leased, transferred or assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to the sale, lease, transfer or discontinuance has first been secured.
3. The authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
