

Decision No. 24118.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

<p>In the matter of the Application of The Western Pacific Railroad Company for authority to discontinue the maintenance of an agency at Clio Station, in the County of Plumas, State of California.</p>

ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation, on July 10, 1931, applied for authority to abandon its agency at Clio Station on the Main Line of its Western Division in Plumas County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that \$258.18 passenger business was transacted at said agency station during the year ending May 31, 1931; that \$720.49 less than carload and \$485.11 carload freight business was transacted during the same period; that the nearest agency to the west is at Blairsden, a distance of 3.3 miles, and to the east at Portola, a distance of 7.8 miles; that the abandonment of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; that the station will be continued as a non-agency station, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation, on July 25th, 1931, signified, in writing, that it does not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Western Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to abandon its agency at its station of Clio, located on the Main Line of its Western Division, in Plumas County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall notify the public of the abandonment of said agency by posting notices for at least ten (10) days in a conspicuous place at said station of Clio.
- (2) Applicant shall continue said station as a non-agency station.
- (3) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (4) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
