BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sacramento, State of California, Howard K. Johnson, Chairman, for order authorizing construction of a grade crossing over the tracks of the Sacramento Southern Railroad (Southern Pacific System), at a point 16,067 feet southerly from Lambert Station.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The County of Sacramento on October 23rd, 1931, advised the Commission, in writing, that the crossing authorized in this proceeding by the Commission's Decision No. 22301, dated April 7th, 1930, would not be completed until about November 15th, 1931, and requested that authority be granted to proceed with the work to its completion, and good cause appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time limit for complying with Decision No. 22301 is hereby extended to and including December 7th, 1931.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, in all other respects, said Decision No. 22301 is hereby reaffirmed and in full force and effect.
