FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant herein having requested modification of Condition No. 4 of the Commission's Decision No. 24067, dated September 26, 1931, in this application, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No. 4 be modified to read as follows:

"No train, motor, engine or car shall enter upon said crossing at a speed greater than ten (10) miles per hour and unless traffic on the highway be protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as flagman."

In all other respects the Commission's Decision No. 24067 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on

the date hereof.
