SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER IN APPLICATION NO. 15311.

The City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles and Salt Lake Rail-  
road Company and Southern Pacific Company, applicants in Applica-  
tion No. 15311 herein, having on November 25th, 1931, requested the  
Commission for a further extension of time of one (1) year in which  
to file the plans for the construction of the grade separation on  
Ninth Street near Lemon Street, as authorized in the Commission's

Decision No. 21090, dated May 15th, 1929, and it appearing to the Commission that this request is reasonable and should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of said Decision No. 21090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) The City of Los Angeles shall, on or before December 31st, 1932, and before the commencement of the construction of said separation, file with the Commission, for its approval, a set of plans for the construction of said separation on Ninth Street near Lemon Street.

In all other respects Decision No. 21090 shall remain in full force and effect.
