BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on December 2, 1931, applied for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Vernon, located on its Knights Landing Branch of its Sacramento Division in Sutter County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger or freight business was transacted at said non-agency station during the year ending October 31, 1931, and that, in applicant's opinion, the continued maintenance of the non-agency is not necessary for the business of applicant or for the public.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, is hereby authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Vernon, located on the Knights Landing Branch of its Sacramento Division, in Sutter County, State of California, to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records and to cancel, in conformity with the rules of this Commission, all rate tariffs and time schedules applying at said station, subject to

the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of the facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent Order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
