ORDER

ORIGINAL

California Water Service Company has applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to execute and deliver a supplemental trust indenture.

The application shows that under authority heretofore granted by this Commission, California Water Service Company has executed and delivered to American Trust Company and Los Angeles-First National Trust & Savings Bank, as trustees, an indenture dated April 1, 1928, together with four indentures supplemental thereto, to secure the payment of its outstanding bonds, and bonds which may hereafter be issued.

The company reports that in order to provide further protection and security to the holders of the bonds issued or to be issued under the indenture and to add to its covenants and agreements, it proposes and desires to execute and deliver a fifth supplemental indenture more specifically describing the properties covered by the

lien of the instrument. A copy of the proposed supplemental indenture is filed in this proceeding as Exhibit "A".

The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed indenture is in satisfactory form, and that its execution and delivery should be authorized, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that California Water Service Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to execute and deliver its fifth supplemental indenture in the same form as that filed as Exhibit "A" in this proceeding, provided that the authority herein granted is for the purpose of this proceeding only, and is granted only insofar as this Commission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act, and is not intended as an approval of said supplemental indenture as to such other legal requirements to which it may be subject.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that within thirty(30) days after the date of the execution of said indenture, California Water Service Company shall file with the Commission two certified copies of said indenture.
