FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Applicant having filed an application for a supplemental order requesting modification of Condition (2) of the Commission's Decision No. 24121, dated October 13, 1931, in this proceeding, and the City of Monterey having stated, in writing, that it is agreeable to a modification of said Condition (2) as hereinafter indicated:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (2) of the Commission's Decision No. 24121, in the above entitled proceeding, be modified to read as follows:

- (2) The entire expense of constructing said crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between applicant and the City of Monterey, copy of which shall be filed with this Commission within ninety (90) days from the date of this order. The maintenance of said crossing in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.

In all other respects, the Commission's Decision No. 24121 shall remain in full force and effect.
