BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for permission to discontinue operation of passenger service by mixed trains Nos. 532 and 533 between Sacramento and Isleton, California.

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, on December 2, 1931, applied for authority to abandon operation of passenger service by mixed trains Nos. 532 and 533 between Sacramento and Isleton, Sacramento County, California.

Applicant alleges that said passenger service is not warranted by the passenger revenues received; that the operation of said passenger service is conducted by applicant at a loss for exemple, for the annual period ending October, 1931, there was only an average of 3.4 passengers carried per month on this line, and that the discontinuance of said service will not constitute an inconvenience to the traveling public.

Both the City Council of Isleton and the California Farm Bureau Federation have signified in writing that they do not object to the granting of this application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is

hereby granted authority to abandon its mixed trains Nos. 532 and 533, operating between Sacramento and Isleton, County of Sacramento, State of California, and to cencel in conformity with the rules of this Commission all passenger rate tariffs and time schedules between said points, unless and until the Commission shall find, after hearing, that public convenience and necessity require the restoration of passenger service upon said railroad line, subject, however, to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall give not less than ten (10) days' notice to the traveling public of said service abandonment by posting a notice in said trains Nos. 532 and 533.
- (2) Applicant shall continue to provide reasonable and adequate freight service between said stations of Sacramento and Isleton.
- (3) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify the Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of said passenger service herein authorized and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (4) The authorization herein granted shall lapso and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective

on the date hereof.
