FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Independent Stage Co., a corporation, has made supplemental application for renewal of a Motor Carrier's Transportation Agent's license for the calendar year 1932. Applicant, after hearing, was granted such a license by Decision No. 24098, dated October 5, 1931, on the original application which license expired, according to law, on December 31, 1931.

The license authorized the establishment of offices at 54 - Fourth Street, San Francisco, with branches at 833 South Grand Avenue, Los Angeles; 757 Howard Street, San Francisco; Hotel San Pablo, 20th Street and San Pablo Avenue, Oakland. Applicant has filed bond which covers the period of 1932, as required by law and the rules of this Commission.

By written amendment applicant asks that authority to establish branch offices at 44 Fourth Street, instead of 54 Fourth Street, San Francisco, and 218 East Seventh Street, instead of 833 South Grand Avenue, Los Angeles. The request will be granted.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and the application should be granted as prayed for.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Secretary of the Railroad Commission of the State of California issue to Independent Stage Co., a corporation, a license to engage in the business of Motor Carrier Transportation Agent, as such is defined by

Chapter 638, Statutes of 1931, at each of the following offices:

- 44 - Fourth Street, San Francisco,
- 757 - Howard Street, San Francisco,
- Hotel San Pablo, San Pablo Avenue and  
20th Street, Oakland,
- 218 East Seventh Street, Los Angeles,

the first named to be the main office of said licensee.

The license authorized hereby is granted under the following conditions:

- 1- That all offices shall be in charge of an officer of the corporation or a salaried employee.
- 2- That said licensee shall accept said license within ten (10) days, said acceptance to contain a declaration that the licenses are accepted with the understanding that they do not constitute an automotive stage line operating right within the purview of the Public Utilities Act, and further, that no transportation shall be sold, arranged for or provided except over the interstate service performed by applicant between California and Oregon points, as described in the original application herein.
