BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The United States Government, on February 2, 1932, applied for authority to construct a public road, at separated grades over the tracks of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company at two points in the vicinity of Ignacio, County of Marin, State of California. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company has signified, in writing, that it has no objection to the construction of said overgrade crossings, and applicant has agreed to bear the entire cost of constructing said crossings. It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein; that it is in the interest of public convenience and necessity that the overgrade crossings be constructed and that the application should be granted, subject to certain conditions,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the United States Government is hereby authorized to construct a public road at separated grade over the tracks of Northwestern Pacific Railroad at two points in the vicinity of Ignacio, County of Marin, State of California, at the locations shown on, and substantially in accordance with the plans attached to the application, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The above crossing of the main line shall be identified as Crossing No. 5-23.4A and that of the spur track as Crossing No. 5-23.5-AC.
- (2) The entire expense of constructing and thereafter maintaining the crossings in good and first-class condition for safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by applicant.
- (3) Applicant shall file, for approval, prior to the commencement of construction of said crossings, a certified copy of an agreement with said Northwestern Pacific Railroad covering the terms of construction and maintenance of said crossings.
- (4) Said crossings shall be constructed with clearances conforming to the provisions of our General Order No. 26-C.
- (5) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said crossings and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.
- (6) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
