FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Upon consideration of the record in the above en-
 titled proceeding, and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the fifth paragraph of the
 order in Decision No. 24423 of January 25, 1932, be and it is
 hereby amended and modified to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pac-
 ific Motor Transport Company operations by
 truck between El Centro and Holtville; Santa
 Barbara and Montecito and Los Angeles and
 Vernon shall within sixty (60) days from the
 effective date of this order be discontinued
 until and when the said Company has first ob-
 tained from this Commission a certificate of
 public convenience and necessity authorizing
 such operations, or until the person or cor-
 poration with whom Pacific Motor Transport

Company has contracted for such service has obtained such certificate."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects our opinion and order entered January 25, 1932, shall remain in full force and effect.
