In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC GREYHOUND LIMES, INC., a corporation, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity declaring its existing operative rights within the State of California in lieu of all previously existing certificates and consolidating its operations into one complete system; also for abandonment of service: Proposed abandonment — Santa Rosa — Petrified Forest — Calistogn.

OBINION

Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. asks authority from the Railroad Commission to abandon its service to transport passengers, baggage and empress "between Santa Rosa and Calistoga via the main highway through Mark West Springs and Petrified Forest" because of losses sustained in the operation. The service cought to be abandoned was granted by Decision No. 23244 on the instant application, original, as a seasonal service approximately between May 15 and October 1, no service being given during the other months. One schedule each way has been operated and the records of the carrier for the season of 1931, extending from May 29 to September 14, inclusive, shows that 226 passengers were transported during the 108 days of operation giving an average of 2.09 passengers per day and approximately one per schedule. revenues for the same period amounted to \$313.50 or an average of \$1.40 per passenger. The revenues per mile of operation of all the schedules during this period averaged 6.9 cents. This is far below the normal cost of operation of the class of vehicles

used by applicant.

Applicant maintains adequate service between Santa Rosa and Calistoga via Napa and the abandonment proposed will not affect the usual passenger transportation except as it traverses the north route through the various springs and other points of sightseeing interest.

We do not believe that this is a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and we find from the facts that the application should be granted.

ORDER

Pacific Greyhound Lines; Inc., a corporation, horeby is authorized to abandon all automotive stage service for passengers, beggage and express between Santa Rosa and Calistoga via Mark West Springs and Petrified Forest as provided for by Decision No. 23244 on Application No. 16989, original, dated December 31, 1930; provided, however, that applicant shall file with the Commission immediately acceptance of this authority together with cancellation and withdrawal of its time schedules and tariffs therefor.
