OPINION

In its Second Supplemental Application Independent Stage Company, a corporation, petitions the Railroad Commission for authority to sell transportation, as a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent, over its interstate service between Los Angeles, California, and Phoenix, Arizona, and all eastern points beyond Phoenix, Arizona, at its principal and/or branch offices, authorized by the Commission's Decision No. 24098, dated October 5, 1931, renewal of same being granted by Decision No. 24422, dated January 25, 1932, which offices are located as follows:

44 Fourth Street, San Francisco, California.
 218 East 7th Street, Los Angeles, California.
 757 Howard Street, San Francisco, California.
 Hotel San Pablo, 20th Street and San Pablo
 Avenue, Oakland, California.

The Commission's Decision No. 24422, above referred to, contained the restriction that no transportation should be sold, arranged for, or provided except over the interstate service performed by the applicant between California and Oregon points. It is the opinion of the Commission that said decision (No. 24422), should be amended to allow applicant to sell transportation over its interstate service between Los Angeles, California, and Phoenix, Arizona, as prayed for in the instant Second Supplemental Application.

A public hearing does not appear necessary and we believe the application should be granted as prayed for.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the restriction contained in Condition No.2 of this Commission's Decision No.24422, dated January 25, 1932, issued on First Supplemental Application No.17621 of Independent Stage Company, a corporation, be and it hereby is amended to permit applicant to sell transportation, as a Motor Carrier Transportation Agent, over its interstate service between Los Angeles, California, and Phoenix, Arizona, and all eastern points beyond Phoenix, Arizona, at its principal and/or branch offices, located as follows:

44 Fourth Street, San Francisco, California.
218 East 7th Street, Los Angeles, California.
757 Howard Street, San Francisco, California.
Hotel San Pablo, 20th Street and San Pablo
Avenue, Oakland, California.

In all other respects Decision No.24422 shall remain unchanged.
